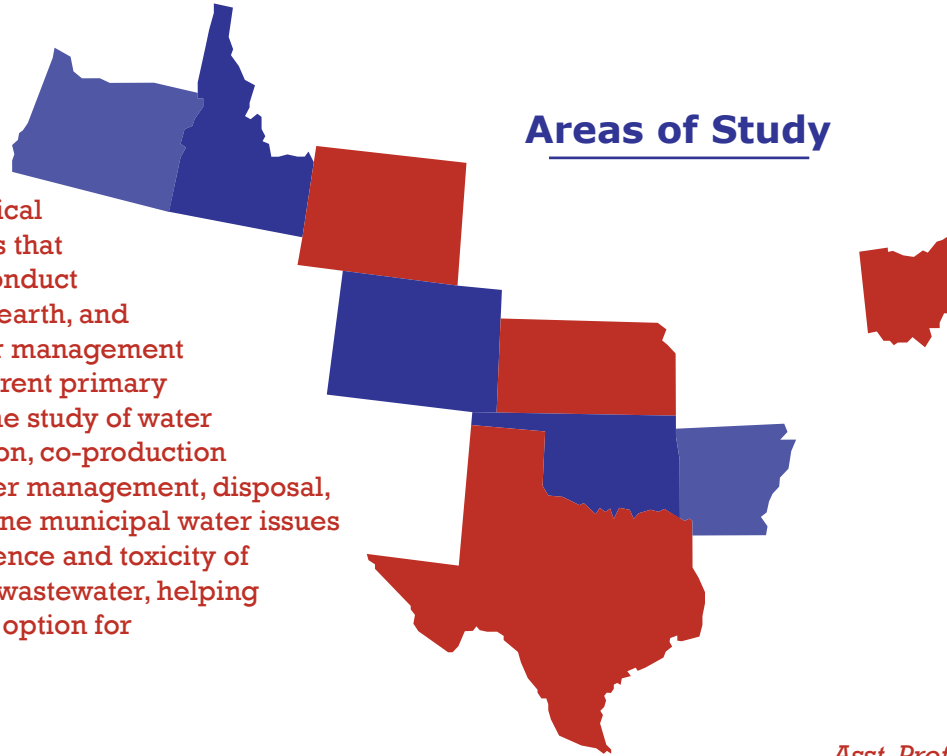

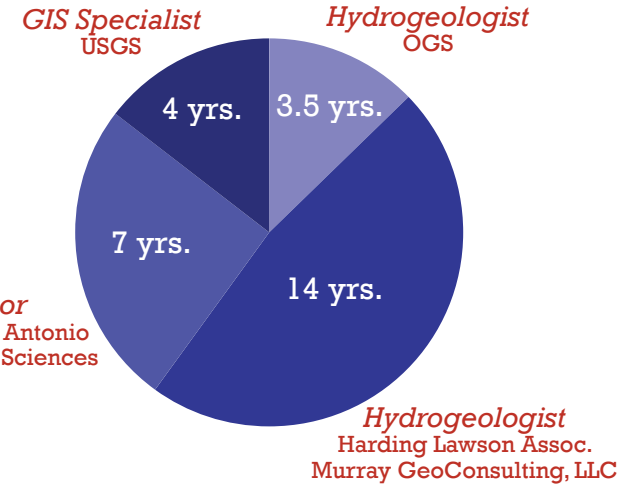
## Research Focus

I investigate physical and chemical properties of geologic materials that store and produce fluids, and conduct regional-scale studies of water, earth, and environmental resources. Water management in the energy industry is my current primary research area, which includes the study of water use in exploration and production, co-production of petroleum and water, saltwater management, disposal, recycle, and reuse. I also examine municipal water issues with an emphasis on the occurrence and toxicity of organic pollutants in water and wastewater, helping to make treatment and reuse an option for future water supply.

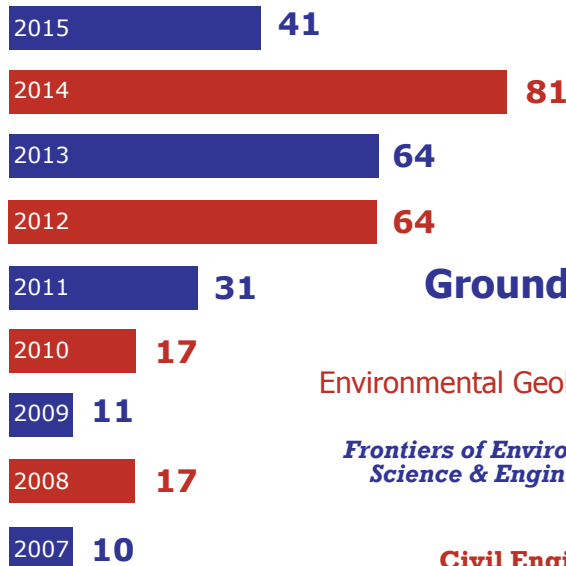
